we assessed over 350 children in various schools for their overall wellness. This included skin checks, heart and lung assessments, fluoride treatments, height and weight assessments and much more. We also installed stoves in several homes and treated the women in Santa Cruz by conducting a clinic and checking their sugar and blood pressures. I am so glad I was able to

go on this trip and love the people of Guatemala," Tatiana said.
