For the 2021-2022 School Year **130** students are receiving a Viner Scholarship, that's up from **124** students last year? The total scholarship amount awarded for this school year is **\$835,000**. This could not have been done without the support from our partners and our community.

Since our inception in 2015 , **72** Viner scholars have graduated with a 4 year Bachelors degree. As of this year, we are approaching 100% graduation rates.

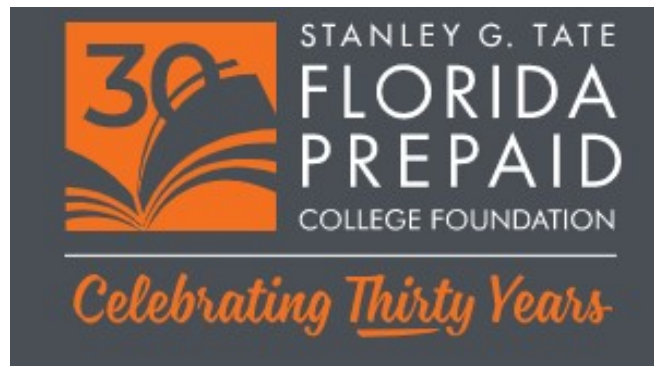

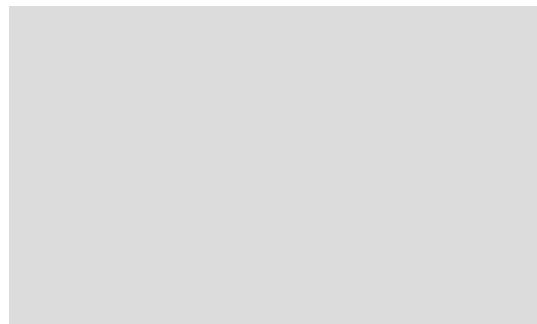
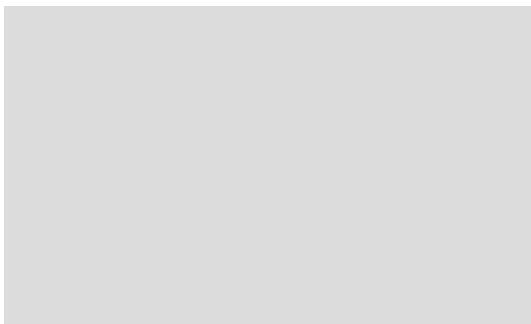


Florida Prepaid Foundation partnered on 24 additional scholarships
